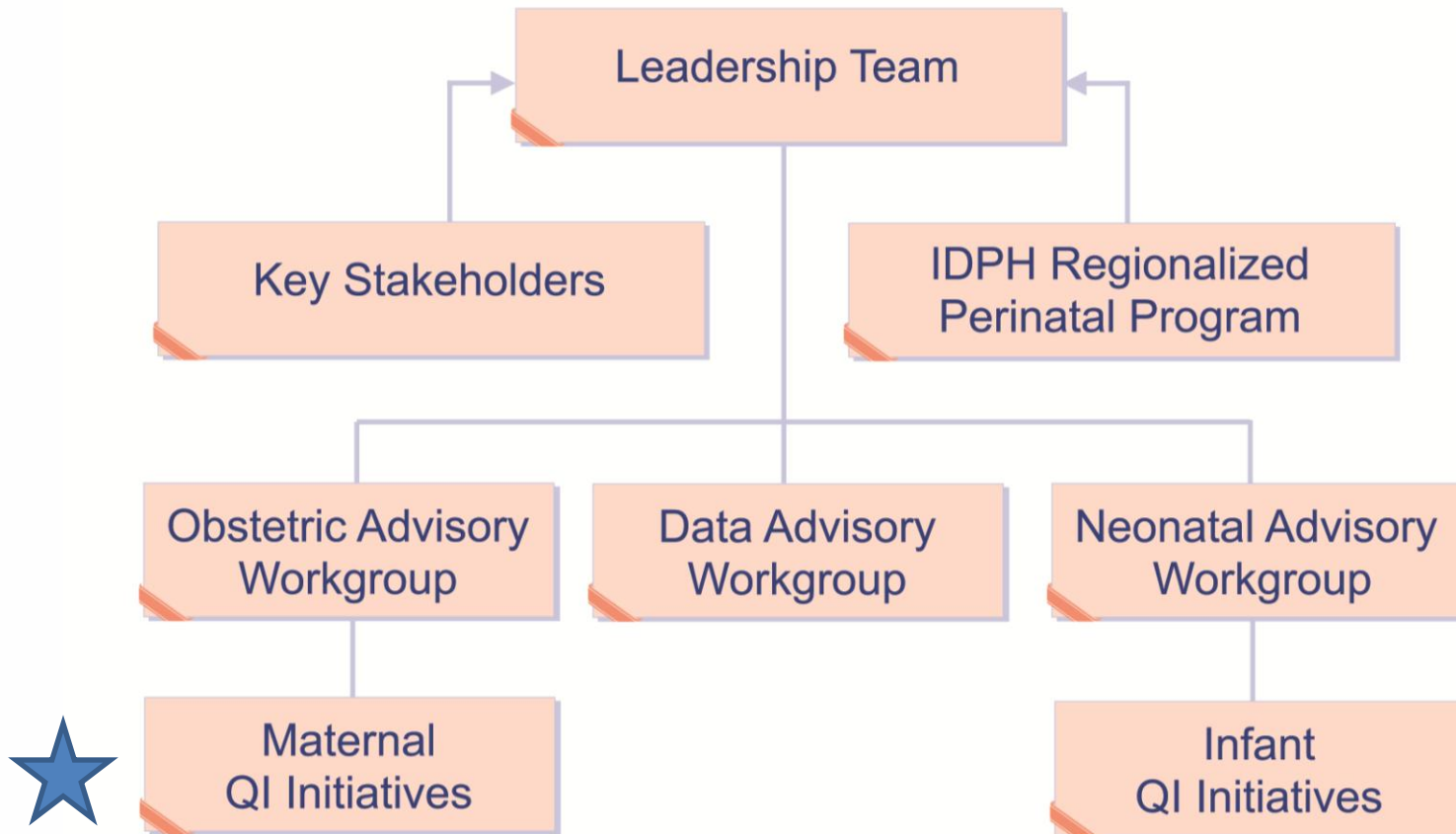

AHRQ Safety Program

- Builds on existing efforts to improve patient safety, team communications, quality of care
- Offers hospitals additional support in clinical quality improvement interventions, team work and communications, and simulation training
- Requires participation in 5 webinars, implementation of a safety intervention, data
- ILPQC working with IHA to pull the data for the intervention for hospitals to avoid data burden for participating hospitals

AHRQ Safety Program: Enrollment Information



- Deadline to enroll: September 10
- Accepting up to 20 IL Hospitals
 - First come, first serve basis
- Enrollment requirements:
 - Ensure commitment from the unit team members who will play a key role in this project,
 - Obtain a commitment letter from your hospital CEO or designee, and
 - Review the data collection requirements and schedule

EED Initiative Data Update

- Data Form
 - PC-01 measure QualityNet data collection for CMS
 - Data Definitions taken from Joint Commission 2014 Manual
 - Instructions for data entry posted on website
- Identify team member who collects PC-01
- Data entry, simple, secure
- Submit data for 2013 Q1-4 and 2014 Q1-2 to receive data report in REDCap by September

REDCap Database Access

- Need REDCap access to begin entering data and to review data reports
- Submit form online at www.ilpq.org
 - Name, email address, title, institution
 - Access Level (data entry and/or report review)
- Please email info@ilpqc.org if you have not received your login information
 - Currently have ~120 users from 47 hospitals

EED Initiative Data Collection

- Hospital Team members have received REDCap User IDs and Hospital IDs
 - Hospital IDs should remain confidential
- Data entry has begun
 - 96 entries from 17 hospitals (as of 8/21/14)
- Complete data entry before Sept Hospital Teams call
- Your hospital data report will be available via your secure portal once report launched: goal by Sept 22

Support for Hospitals

- Goal: to have EED rates <5%
 - See improvement over time
- Hospitals with rates <5%
 - Letter of Commendation from ILPQC – need input
 - Request for materials to share with other hospitals – can post on website or compile packet
- Hospitals with rates >5%
 - Provide outreach – share hospital materials
 - Grand rounds offer
 - Share new NQF Maternity Action Team 2014: Playbook for Successful Elimination of EED
